English

- ▶ In English our topic is Heroes we will be learning about David Attenborough and Marie Curie.
- ▶ We will be writing a report about our favourite hero and we will be learning about using paragraphs and direct speech.
- ▶ We will create and invent our own versions of the report over the course of the half term.



We will be working on our writing by...

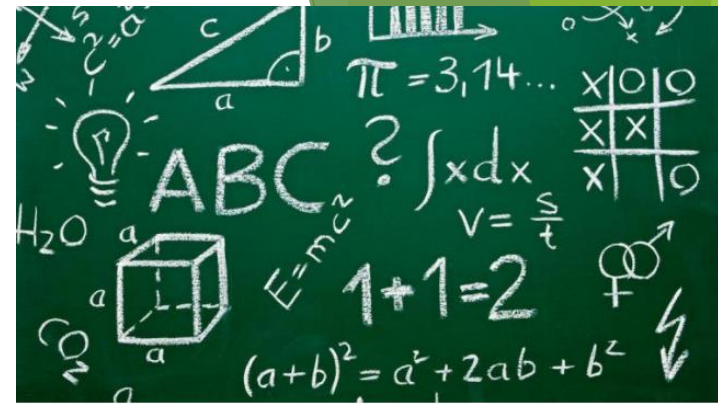
- ▶ Use the first two or three letters of a word to check its spelling in a dictionary.
- ▶ Expressing time, place using conjunctions (*eg, when, before, after, while, so, because*), adverbs (*eg, then, next, soon, therefore*), or prepositions (*eg, before, after, during, in, because of*).
- ▶ Write from memory simple sentences, dictated by the teacher, that include words and punctuation that that already been taught. You could help your child by choosing sentences from a book and asking them to repeat it back to you.



Handwriting

- ▶ We will continue to work on our handwriting learning how to form our letters correctly.
- ▶ We will look at line guides and how to use them.
- ▶ We will practise the size and orientation of our letters on the line guide so that our work is beautifully neat in our books.

Maths



- ▶ This half term we will be continuing to develop our number skills.
- ▶ We will be continuing to learn about addition and subtraction.
- ▶ We will move on to looking at multiplication and division.

Topic and Science

- ▶ In topic we will be learning about some of our heroes and what they achieved.
- ▶ In science we are learning about plants and the natural world.
- ▶ In geography we are learning about the different regions of the world and their different climates.



RE

- ▶ We will look at seasonal events and talk about why we celebrate them e.g. Christmas and Easter. There will be a Christmas performance at the end of the Autumn term.
- ▶ We will explore how different people celebrate things differently in RE.



PE



- ▶ We will take part in PE lessons twice a week. Please ensure that your child brings the correct kit which includes; a plain white T shirt, black shorts or jogging bottoms depending on the weather.
- ▶ We will be following the Real PE scheme of work which focusses on developing positive relationships with physical activity for life.
