

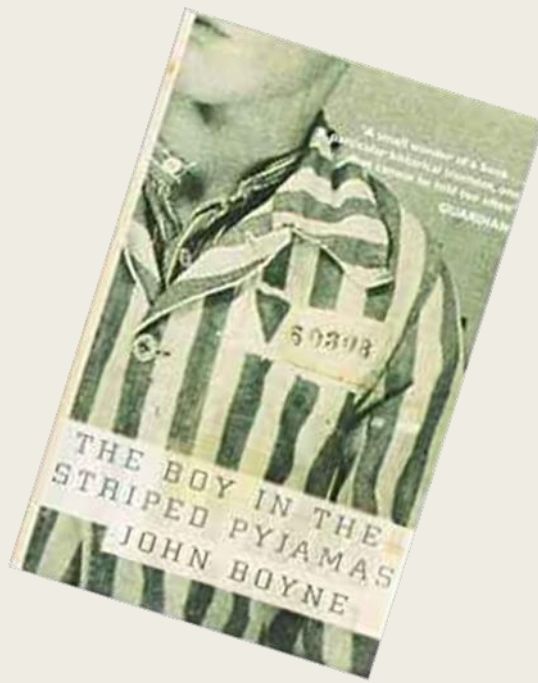

Our children will predict what is going to happen in the story based on the blurb before delving into the book itself.

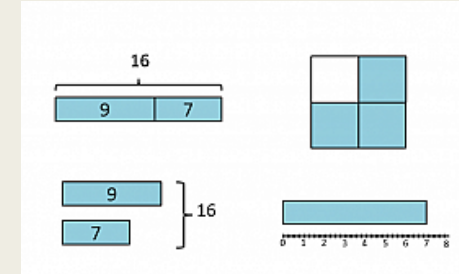
The children will be learning how to answer a range of SATS style questions based on this text.

Using our SDI approach the year 6 children will answer 5 progressive questions every day. Through high quality first teaching, the children will then move onto hot (mastery) extra hot (mastery with greater depth) questions. Same day intervention will be used for children identified as needing extra support to achieve the learning objective that day, so that they are ready for the new learning tomorrow.

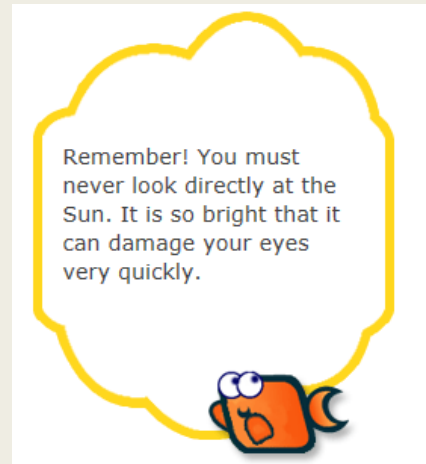
