

Year 4 - Summer 1

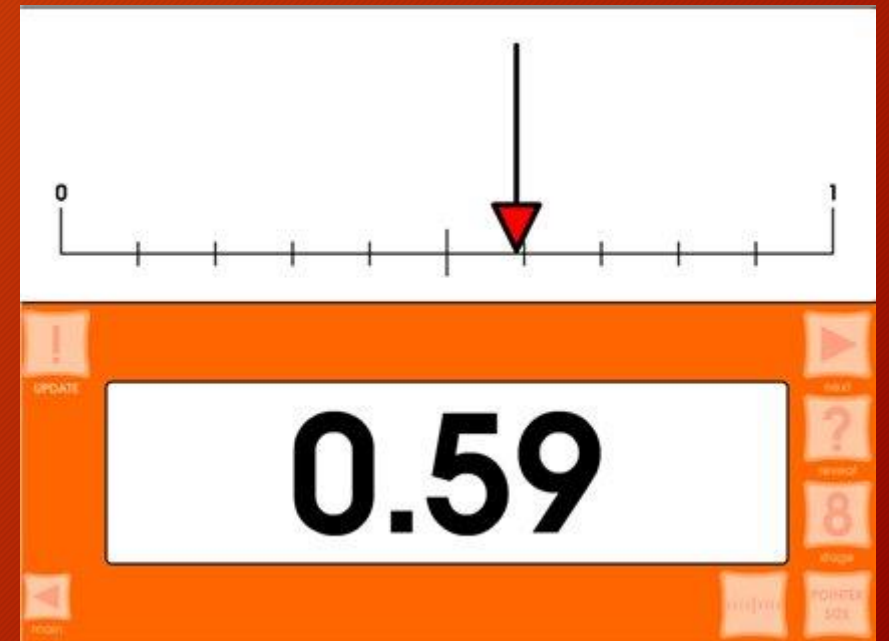


Writing

- In writing, the children of Year 4 will focus on a news report. They will use a range of formal language such as: prepositions, fronted adverbials and dialogue to create a newspaper report about the Tutankhamen.
- We will also be writing adventure stories that create suspense based in an Egyptian setting.

Maths

- In maths, we will be focusing on fractions and decimal numbers. We will also be focusing on daily arithmetic skills based around decimals and fractions and how they can be multiplied by numbers such as 10 and 100.



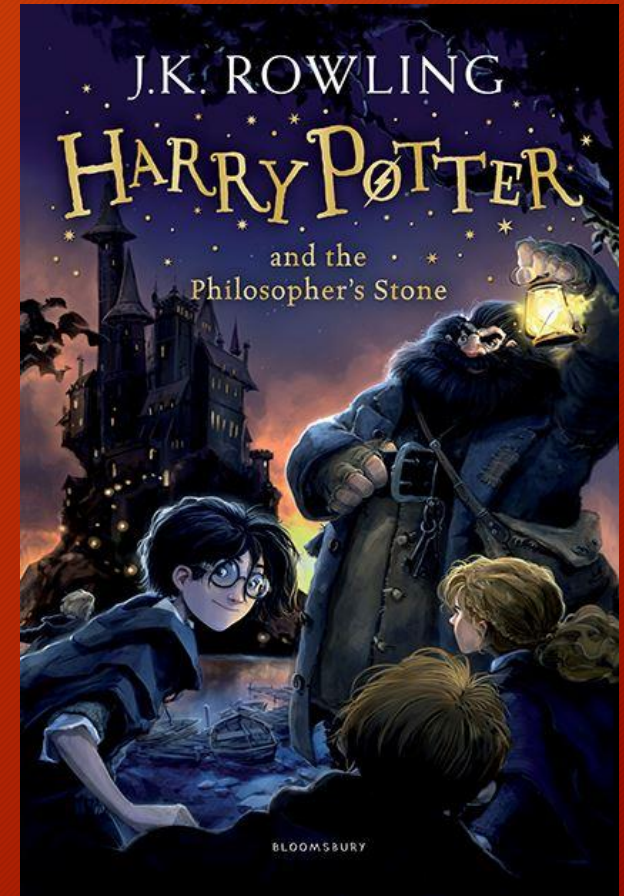
Science

- Our science topic this half term is 'Human impact'. The children will conduct scientific investigations to study how humans affect their local environment and the global environment. They will examine how litter affects animals both in school and in the ocean.



Reading

- Our main reading focus this half term will be based around Harry Potter and the philosophers stone. We will continue to develop our reading skills whilst studying this text.
- The children will study the authors use of language and make inference about what they have read.



Topic

- Map skills will be used to locate Egyptian seas, cities and rivers
- The children will compare the weather in Egypt to the weather of Rossington (Temperature graph). The children will also compare the differences in landmarks in Egypt to those in their local area.
- The children will write a tourist booklet about why people should travel to Egypt.
- The children will create a timeline of ancient Egypt and the events that's taken place.
- The children will create a Tutankhamen mask



RE/PSHE

- The children will be investigating what is the best way for a Jewish person to show commitment to God
- In PSHCE, we will be learning about different relationships.
