First, we will be focusing on text features which include adjectives for positive description and learning how to structure a formal letter.


Next, we will focus on our grammar by using fronted adverbials, rhetorical questions and subordinate clauses.

Then, we will use a full range of punctuation, ensuring we use capital letters for proper nouns, using ? And ! for rhetorical and exclamatory sentences and commas to make fronted adverbial and subordinate clauses.

English

We will also be writing to entertain.

Alliteration, similes, dialogue, repetition for effect and precise verbs will make our writing exciting for the audience to read.



We will be asking questions to improve our understanding of the text

We will be drawing inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions, and justifying inferences with evidence

We will be predicting what might happen from details stated and implied and we will be identifying main ideas from the text.

We are excited to continue reading the book - *Charlotte's Web* by E. B. White.

Maths

This half term, we will learn how to add and subtract fractions with the same denominators.

Then, we will solve problems that involves comparing and ordering fractions.

Next, we will interpret and present data using bar charts and tables

Finally, we will solve one-step and two-step questions (for example, 'How many more?' and 'How many fewer?') using information presented in scaled bar charts and tables.

Science - Our topic this half term is *Amazing Bodies*.

We will learn to:

Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat

Identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

Topic

We will be learning about the countries located on the Equator, as well as identifying the position of the Northern and Southern Hemispheres.

We will use maps, atlases, globes and digital mapping to locate these countries
